Minutes of the Williamson County Historical Commission

A regular meeting of the Williamson County Historical Commission was held on **Thursday, October 4th**, **2007** at the Williamson County Historical Museum at 716 S Austin Avenue in Georgetown, Texas. Volunteers are needed to do some research. There are only a couple of copies of the survey but they are very thick. The library has a copy and the heritage society has a copy. Renee of GHS has become in charge of this. Renee's primary concern is that the new survey opens the way for McMansions.

A discussion occurred regarding possible memorial projects for Laverne Faubian.

Committee reports:

The cemetery committee report was presented in writing by David Hollingsworth.

The museum committee report was given by Bob Brinkman. The Chisholm Trail event was a success. Archeology Day will be held on Saturday, October 13th at Berry Springs Park. The Swedish Texas exhibit grand opening will be November 7th.

The marker committee report was given by Bob Brinkman. Possible upcoming marker applications are for the Chautauqua encampment in Georgetown, Rocky Hollow Cemetery, and St. John's Cemetery.

The infrastructure committee report was presented in writing by David Hollingsworth.
