

WILLIAMSON COUNTY HISTORICAL COMMISSION

November 8, 2012

Williamson County Courthouse, 2nd Floor

The meeting was called to order at 4:10p.m. by Chair Patrick J. Stevens. Ten members were present. The December meeting will be held at Gumbo's on December 13th at 6:30p.m. Reading of the October minutes was deferred until the December meeting. Treasurer Mildred Davis reported that expenditures for October were \$130 with income of \$55.30 leaving a balance of \$13,851.97. Winnann Ewing moved that the report be approved, PJ Stevens seconded; the Treasurer's report was approved. Dues of \$30 for the National Trust for Preservation was discussed.

A motion was made by Kandy Dipprey that a brick be purchased for Coop Smith, Marietta Mugford seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Wayne Ware shared an article from the Statesman about the Georgetown IOOF Cemetery. The cemetery behind Wolf Ranch was discussed. It was suggested that we try to get a historical category for it. Wayne described the on going work at an unclaimed historical cemetery west of Texas Corregated off Hwy 79 before 130. The McNutt cemetery. He reported that about \$1000 would be needed to cover materials for fencing the cemetery. Laura Sue Smith made a motion that WCHC donate up to \$1000 to cover the cost of fencing for the historical unclaimed cemetery. Kandy seconded. The motion was passed. A proposal was made to have an on site meeting after the work was done with media coverage if possible. Work on the Lawrence/Capple Cemetery is still in progress.

There is still a problem with getting bricks installed at the courthouse. The work is done on a volunteer basis. PJ reported that he had a stack in his office waiting to be installed.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
